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11 DAYS / 9 NIGHTS BALKAN EXPERIENCE

BOSNIA & HERZEGOVINA – CROATIA - MONTENEGRO

DAY 1 : SINGAPORE – ISTANBUL – SARAJEVO (Lunch / Dinner)

Depart from Singapore to Sarajevo via Istanbul on 1 Dec @ 0005am. Upon arrival into Sarajevo at 1100 am meet and greet by local guide. Visit **Tunnel of hope museum The Sarajevo Tunnel**, also known as *Tunel spasa* and *Tunnel of Hope*, was an underground tunnel constructed between March and June 1993 during the Siege of Sarajevo in the midst of the Bosnian War , **Gazi Husrev Bey Mosque** The Gazi Husrev-bey Mosque, is a mosque in the city of Sarajevo, Bosnia and Herzegovina. Built in 16th century, it is the largest historical mosque in Bosnia and Herzegovina and one of the most representative Ottoman structures in the Balkans , **Barcarsija** Sarajevo's old bazaar and the historical and cultural center of the city. Barcarsija was built in the 15th century when Isa-Beg Isaković founded the town. **Sarajevo meeting of the culture place. Overnight in Sarajevo.**

DAY 2 : SARAJEVO – TRAVNIK – JAJCE – SARAJEVO (BFAST / LUNCH / DINNER)

Morning after breakfast visit **Travnik fortress Central Bosnia , Avnoï museum , Serena Mosque , Pliva River , Jajce Waterfall (candidate UNESCO)** - The town is also famous for its beautiful waterfall where the Pliva River meets the river Vrbas. It was 30 meters high, but during the Bosnian war, the area was flooded and the waterfall is now 20 meters high. The flooding may have been due to an earthquake and/or attacks on the hydroelectric power plant further up the river. Jajce is situated in the mountains, there is a beautiful countryside near the city, rivers such as the Vrbas and Pliva, lakes like Pliva lake, which is also a popular destination for the local people and some tourists. This lake is called Brana in the local parlance. Not far from Jajce there are mountains that are over 2000 meters high like Vlasica near the city of Travnik. Travelling through the mountain roads to the city may not sit well with some visitors, because the roads are in poor condition, but the scenery is picturesque. **Overnight in Sarajevo.**

DAY 3 : SARAJEVO – MOSTAR (BFAST / LUNCH / DINNER)

After breakfast at hotel , visit **Koski Mehmet Pasha Mosque** - This mosque was built at the beginning of the 17th century by Koski Mehmed-Pasha. From the minaret, at only five metres from the Neretva River, a spectacular panoramic view of the city can be enjoyed. The welcoming atmosphere within the courtyard offers a pleasant, relaxing break in a unique and romantic context. **Turkish House Mostar , Hamam** - It is the only Turkish bath still existing in Mostar and one of the few remaining examples in the whole of Herzegovina , **Old Bridge (UNESCO)** The Old Bridge area of the Old City of Mostar , **old Bridge (Small bridge).** **Overnight in Mostar.**

DAY 4 : MOSTAR – BLAGAJ – POCITEL – KRAVICA – MOSTAR (BFAST / LUNCH / DINNER)

Today visit **Blagaj Tekija** is a Dervish monastery outside Mostar, Bosnia, that's nearly 600 years old. Situated at the base of a cliff, next to the source of the river Buna. **Pocitel Old Town , Sisman Ibrahim Pasha Mosque, Kravica Waterfall** - Among the most fascinating naturalistic features of the Herzegovinian region are the sparkling waterfalls of Kravice. **Spring of river Buna** The source of the Buna is one of the largest and most beautiful in Europe. It is the finest example of an underground karst river. It flows out of a 200m cliff wall and single-handedly creates the Buna River. **Overnight in Mostar.**

DAY 5 : MOSTAR – DUBROVNIK (BFAST / LUNCH / DINNER)

After breakfast , visit **Franciscan Monastery (Old Pharmacy)** It consists of a monastery, a church, a library and a pharmacy. It is situated at the Placa, the main street of Dubrovnik, Croatia. Dubrovnik Mosque. Rectors palace , Old Port , Onofrios Fountain , Clock Tower. **Overnight in Dubrovnik.**

DAY 6 : DUBROVNIK – KOTOR – DUBROVNIK (BFAST / LUNCH / DINNER)

After breakfast , visit **Kotor Old Town (UNESCO)** , **Tivat Mosque (house converted into Mosque)** , **Kotor Port , Pillar of shame , Weapons Square , Square of Churches , City Hall . Overnight in Dubrovnik.**

DAY 7 : DUBROVNIK - SPLIT (BFAST / LUNCH / DINNER)

After breakfast , visit **Diocletian Palace (UNESCO)** - *Diocletian's Palace is an ancient palace built for the Roman Emperor Diocletian at the turn of the fourth century AD, that today forms about half the old town of Split, Croatia.*
Split Mosque , Old Town of Split. **Overnight in Split.**

DAY 8 : SPLIT – ZADAR – RIJEKA (BFAST / LUNCH / DINNER)

After breakfast , visit **Zadar Old Town , Rijeka Mosque , Sun Salutation** - *the Sun Salutation installation is a circle of LEDs and photovoltaic cells (solar panels) that come alive at night to create the most colorful sunset you'll ever see. Just these two experiences make Zadar worth a visit!* **Sea Organo** - *is an architectural object located in Zadar, Croatia and an experimental musical instrument, which plays music by way of sea waves and tubes located underneath a set of large marble steps.* **Overnight in Rijeka.**

DAY 9 : RIJEKA – PLITVICE - ZAGREB (BFAST / LUNCH / DINNER)

After breakfast , visit **Plitvice National Park , Upper Lakes** - *National park Plitvice Lakes is considered one of the most beautiful national parks in the world. Plitvice Lakes make wonderful blend of oak forests, meadows, rocks and lakes. You can explore them by walking along the lakes, by electric train or electric boat.* **Overnight in Zagreb.**

DAY 10 : ZAGREB – ISTANBUL - SINGAPORE (BFAST / LUNCH)

After breakfast , visit **Zagreb Islamic Centre & Mosque, Zagreb old Airport Town , Zagreb Cathedral , Kaptol & Gradec.** Late afternoon transfer to airport for flight back to Singapore via Istanbul.
