### DAY 1 : SINGAPORE – CASABLANCA (MEALS ON BOARD)

Gather at Changi Airport Terminal 1. Depart for Casablanca via Istanbul.

### DAY 2: ARRIVAL CASABLANCA (DINNER)

Meet and greet at Casablanca Airport by our local representative. Discover the economic capital of Morocco, the Beautiful pearl of the Atlantic Ocean, the city of Islamic heritage and today the most luxury and wealthy city of Morocco, a city not only for Kings and Princes, with its beautiful surroundings. The atmosphere has a unique beauty and mystic which you will never find in the world. Visit Habous district, Mohamed V Square and the residential area of Anfa, and see the facade of Mosque Hassan II, which has the tallest minaret in the world. **Halal dinner** and overnight in Casablanca.

### DAY 2: CASABLANCA – MARRAKECH (BFAST – LUNCH – DINNER)

Breakfast. Visit the impressive king Hassan II Muslim Centre including the exterior of the giant Mosque, which can hold 25,000 worshippers, making it one of the most impressive Mosques in the World. You will be taken through the most beautiful locations like the old city and to enjoy the beautiful harbor of "Ainsbai". **Halal Lunch** Depart to **Marrakech**, Spread around the Medina and Djemaa El Fna square and its souqs. Free time to enjoy amazing Efna Square Cultural Heritage of Marrakech. **Halal dinner** and overnight in Marrakech.

### DAY 3: MARRAKECH (BFAST – LUNCH – DINNER)

Breakfast. City Tour enjoying the Pearl of the South and one of the Imperial cities of Morocco. Serving as the capital of southern Morocco, the city of Marrakech is one of the most visited countries. This colorful oasis retains a rather exotic flavour with some of its 16Km mud brick ramparts still standing. Marrakech is now something of a Moroccan tourism heaven and is home to the south's premier Souq (market). Founded almost 1,000 years ago, the character of Marrakech remains quite unchanged, being hot, full of energy and somewhat African. Walk through the Menara in the olive fields, visit the Bahia Palace. **Halal lunch**. The Koutoubia Mosque is one of the most eye-catching of Marrakech. **Halal dinner** and overnight in Marrakech.

### DAY 4: MARRAKECH – RABAT – MEKNES – FES (BFAST – LUNCH – DINNER)

Breakfast. Continue to **Rabat**, the elegant and green administrative Capital of Morocco. Enjoy one of the Morocco's imperial cities, known for its large avenues and green gardens. Modern Rabat is clean and open. It is surrounded by both old Muslim quarters as well as beautiful remains from all periods of Moroccan history. Embark on a city tour which includes the Royal Palace area, Mausoleum of Mohammed V and Hassan Tower. **Halal lunch**. Continue to the Imperial City of **Meknes**, the city of olive groves founded by the Meknasa tribe, after whom it was named. This small city was expanded in the era of Sultan Abdetmoumen in 1145 as well as during the glorious era of the Alaouite King Moulay Ismail. Visit the Ismailian Capital, famous for its 40-kilometre-long walls. Visit the Old Medina, Souqs and Moulay Ismail Mosque square with its old shrine. Proceed to **Fez** or, as some spell it, *Fes* – the Moroccan city with the shortest name and the longest past, as well as the oldest Imperial City of the entire Kingdom. **Halal dinner** and overnight in Fes.

### DAY 5: FES – TANGIER (BFAST – LUNCH – DINNER)

Breakfast. Your City Tour of Fez will include viewing the exterior of the Royal Palace, though general public are barred from entering the Palace, but it is still an impressive sight even from outside. The **Mosque of Bouanania**, built between 1350 and 1357, is the biggest in Fes, and the hallmark of Merenid architecture. The **University of al-Qarawiyyin** is a university located in Fes, Morocco. It is the oldest existing, continually operating and the first degree awarding educational institution in the world according to UNESCO and Guinness World Records and is sometimes referred to as the oldest university. The al-Qarawiyyin mosque - religious school was founded by Fatima Al-Fihri in 859 with an associated madrasa. **Halal lunch**. In the afternoon, proceed to Tangier including an orientation visit of

this city. The **Medina**, a walled city lively with its alleyways which are filled with shops and tea-houses; located high on a hill in Tangier with some good views of the ocean is **The Kasbah**. The **Old Sultan's Palace** (17<sup>th</sup> century), lying within the Kasbah's walls, is known as *Dar El Makhzen* and it is now a museum that houses fine examples of Moroccan Art. Tangier's **Grand Mosque** is a large mosque in the Grand Souq area of central Tangier. It was built on the site of a former Portuguese cathedral which in turn stood on a Roman temple dedicated to *Hercules*. The mosque dates back to the Moulay Ismail period and was expanded in 1815 by Moulay Suliman. **Halal dinner** and Overnight in Tangier.

#### **DAY 6: TANGIER PORT – TARIFA/ALGECIRAS – GRANADA (BFAST – LUNCH – DINNER)**

Breakfast. Check on board a ferry at the port of Tangier Med and cross the **Strait of Gibraltar**, which separates the Atlantic Ocean and the Mediterranean Sea, to **Spain**. Meet and greet at Tarifa/Algeciras Port by our local representative and travel to **Granada** -the City of Faith and Justice-. **Halal lunch**. Also known as *Gharnada*, this magnificent kingdom produces astounding architecture and a rich tradition that still influences the lives of the people of present-day Andalusia. Embark on a walking tour to unravel the Islamic heritage of this enchanting kingdom, its Arab baths, its guest houses, its markets. **Halal dinner** and overnight in Granada.

#### **DAY 7: GRANADA – ALHAMBRA\* - SIERRA NEVADA SKI STATION (BFAST – LUNCH – DINNER)**

Breakfast. Marvel at the architecture, the **Alhambra\***, the red fortress built on top of a hill and the biggest attraction in Spain. It is a fairy-tale fortress created by Muslim architects, engineers, artists and craftsmen who put their heart and soul, inspired by the Quran to build an exquisite abode, where the motto is "There is no Victorious but Allah". Explore this incredible fortress with its Quranic scripts and Arabic poetry, crowning our visit by admiring the Jannat al-Arif, the garden of paradise, now called the Generalife. See how light, wind and water have been utilized to create a serene and relaxing bliss. Visit and prayers at the **New Granada Mosque** and explore the old city of **Albaicin**, where the medieval mystique atmosphere is still alive. Enjoying the Elvira Street Al-Qaisaria, founded by Yusuf I and called Yussufiya, as one of the famous Madrasa in Islamic Heritage of Al-Andalus. After lunch proceed to Sierra Nevada Ski Station (subject to weather condition and time). Evening free time for shopping at Serrallo Plaza. **Halal Dinner** and overnight in Granada. **\*Alhambra Tour pending on available access to Nazaris Palaces ticket / \*Sierra Nevada subject to weather and time. Program might change due to available timing of entry to Alhambra.**

#### **DAY 8: GRANADA – CÓRDOBA – SEVILLE (BFAST – LUNCH – DINNER)**

Breakfast. Check out and travel to the magnificent city of the Caliphate "Córdoba". Start your Tour in *Qurtuba* with a stroll through the cobbled streets of this jewel city of the Middle Ages. Be spellbound by the **Mezquita**, the exquisite mosque started by Abdul Rahman I and expanded by his successors. **The Great Mosque -Aljama- of Córdoba**, as it is also known, built during the period of Moorish occupation, is the most splendid Islamic monument in the western world. Its construction commenced in 785, when Abd Rahman established Córdoba as capital of Al-Andalus; it was extended during successive periods by Abd Rahman II, Al-Hakam II and Almanzor. Crossing the **Roman Bridge** till the **Calaà Hurra**, the Islamic fortified gate in the historic centre. **Halal lunch**. Visit and prayers in **Mosque of Avorroes**. Proceed our travel to Seville As it is commonly known, *Ishbiliya* or Sevilla is Spain's most beautiful city. The Muslims left a rich legacy in this historical city that gave birth to a culture which was the epitome of the refinement of the Moorish-Andalusian heritage. Visit what was once the main Mosque, which was demolished and replaced by a **Gothic Cathedral**. The marvelous minaret, the **Giralda**, is still standing and is one of the most awesome sights to behold. **Dinner** and overnight in **Seville**

#### **DAY 9: SEVILLA – TOLEDO – MADRID (BFAST – LUNCH – DINNER)**

Breakfast at hotel. After check-out, we will leave Sevilla with destination to our charming **Toledo**. **Halal lunch** by the road. Located at 70 Km south of Madrid, it was declared a World Heritage Site by UNESCO in 1986 for its extensive cultural and monumental heritage and historical co-existence of Christian, Muslim and Jewish cultures (also known as the Imperial city and *City of the Three Cultures*). Visiting the **Old city** and its renamed places with their very Hispanic feelings. Proceed our trip to **Madrid**. We will spend one last evening in the wonderful ambience of this world-class European city, walking by its memorable streets and relaxed shopping. **Halal dinner** and overnight in Madrid.

#### **DAY 10: MADRID (BFAST – LUNCH – DINNER)**

Breakfast. Enjoy the panoramics of **Bullring of Madrid Las Ventas** and proceed to **Real Madrid Stadium Santiago Bernabeu** -one of the best clubs worldwide- outside camp.
